A Checklist for New Homeowners

Know your major systems

Ask the previous owner or the person who inspects your home where to find and how to use the following:

- \Box fuse box or circuit breakers
- \square main water cut-off value
- \square hot water heater
- \Box outside faucets
- \Box gas supply line
- □ furnace
- □ air conditioner
- \Box sump pump (if you have one)
- \Box smoke alarms
- □ storm windows/window screens

Obtain manuals and warranties

Ask the prior owner to give you all manuals and warranties for the following: \Box refrigerator

- □ stove
- □ furnace
- \square hot water heater
- □ air conditioner
- □ washer
- □ dryer

Other appliances:

Local collection services

Ask the previous owner or a neighbor when the following take place:

- \Box garbage collection
- \Box recycling collection
- □ collection for leaves, yard work, larger items

Utilities

Ask the previous owner or a neighbor for the name, address, and phone number of the utility companies in your area. Or look in the blue pages of your phone book to find them.

- \Box electricity
- □ water
- □ gas
- □ local telephone
- \Box long-distance telephone
- \Box cable

Location of local services

Before you move in, find out the location of some local services you may use, such as:

- □ nearest hospital
- \Box public schools
- \Box adult education classes
- □ library
- □ park
- □ recreation center
- □ pharmacy
- \Box grocery store
- □ public transportation
