Comparing two things or two groups of things
The comparative degree of one-syllable adjectives is formed by adding <i>er</i> . One-syllable comparative = adjective + er Example: (small-smaller) Town houses are smaller than Victorian houses.
The comparative degree of adjectives with more than two syllables is formed by using more. More than two syllables = more + adjective Example: (expensive-more expensive) Large houses are more expensive than small houses.

The comparative form of all adjectives is followed by *than* plus the second item being compared.

Use the comparative degree of adjectives to write sentences about the differences between old homes and new homes.
