- 1. Match a Profile asks you to plug in a student's four grade-equivalent scores and oral reading rate. A profiler analyzes the data and provides helpful instructional suggestions.*
- 2. The Mini-Course track gives detailed information on the numerous components of reading and provides a number of useful, downloadable resources.
